- According to a national study of 4,500 hospitals, Parkway Medical Center has been named a **Top 100 Hospital™** by the 2009-2010 Hospital Value Index™.
- The study is a thorough independent analysis conducted by Data Advantage, LLC, the nation's leader in measuring healthcare value.
- Data Advantage reviewed the most recent publicly available hospital performance data for 4,500 hospitals across the U.S.
- The 2009-2010 Hospital Value Index™ ultimately ranked 3,000 general acute-care hospitals, serving approximately 30.1 million patients.
- Of all the hospitals in the nation, Parkway is ranked #28 for delivering healthcare at an extraordinary value, which is an overall measure of a hospital's Quality, Efficiency, Affordability, and Patient Satisfaction.
- The primary data sources for each element are:
 - Quality: Reported by Center for Medicare & Medicaid Services' Core Measures Program;
 - Efficiency: Reported by hospital filings with CMS, including the relative measure of the cost to the hospital for providing services;
 - Affordability: Reported by hospital filings with CMS, a relative comparison of prices charged for inpatient and outpatient services; and
 - Patient satisfaction: Reported in the Hospital Consumer Assessment of Health Plans Survey (HCAHPS) submissions to CMS.
